**The criteria for student selection are:**

1. Must be able to complete enhanced course work in mathematics and/or science. Priority is given to students going into the sixth grade;
2. Evidence of the student's interest and aptitude for rigorous mathematics and science courses;
3. Must be a sixth through twelfth grade student maintaining at least a C average with an interest in mathematics and/or science.
4. Must be willing to commit to the total program (Saturday Academy programs and Summer Program, etc). Please pay special attention to information outlined in the Rules and Regulations Guidelines;
5. Must not have exemplified a disciplinary problem in their regular school curriculum;
6. Must complete the online enrollment packet (incomplete application packets will not be previewed by the Pre-College Office).
7. Parents are expected to participate in the Parents Involved for Excellence (PIE) Club at the school where their child is an active participant. Studies indicate there is a direct relationship with student success and parent participation.

## **MSEN Pre-College Enrichment Activity Student Guidelines**

As representative of yourselves, your family, school, and the UNC-Chapel Hill MSEN Pre-College Program, nothing less than your best behavior will be acceptable for all activities associated with the Pre-College Program. To insure a successful enrichment activity for all, please review each expectation, conduct yourself accordingly and come prepared for an enjoyable learning experience. Please sign and return the attached page after reviewing these guidelines.

### **MSEN Pre-College Student Expectations**

1. Students will attend class on time, mentally and physically prepared to learn.
2. Students will respect the property of others, and that of UNC-Chapel Hill. We ask that you dispose of all litter in its proper place and recycle.
3. Students will cease from wearing hats (“team caps”) in the building. If improperly worn the hats/caps will be confiscated for the duration of the session.
4. Students will refrain from bringing distractible items such as walkmans, radios, game boys, pagers, cell phones, etc.
5. Food will be eaten during break only. No food/drink are allowed in the classroom.
6. Students will pass quietly from class to break, since other classes may still be in progress.
7. Students will respect teachers and other students right to learn. Strong, loud, abrasive and profane language will not be tolerated at any time. Disruptive and undesirable classroom behavior may result in your parent(s) meeting you in Chapel Hill and/or dismissal from the enrichment activity and from the Pre-College Program.
8. Students will wear attire deemed appropriate for school that will not be disruptive to the educational process.
9. Valuables such as large sums of money and jewelry should be left at home.
10. Student activities are restricted to the buildings in the quad area. The Student Union and other campus buildings will be off limits to all enrichment activity participants.

### **MSEN Pre-College Student Dress Code**

1. No pants that hang low on the waist will be allowed. No extreme sagging of the pants will be allowed. Belts should be worn if needed.
2. No halter-tops, or short shorts will be allowed; therefore no midriffs should be exposed.
3. No suggestive “tee shirts”, advertising cigarettes, alcohol, illegal drugs, etc., will be allowed.
4. Sandals are acceptable, but no flip-flops should be worn.
5. Students should not wear expensive jewelry on campus.

**MSEN Pre-College Program Parent/Student Agreement**
