CHAPEL HILL, NC – The College Sport Research Institute and the Department of Exercise and Sport Science at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill announce the **CSRI Case Study Competition** to be held at the **2010 Scholarly Conference on College Sport**. The event will take place at the **William and Ida Friday Center** in Chapel Hill from **April 21-23, 2010**.

Teams of either undergraduate or graduate students may participate in the competition. The teams will receive details about the case at conference registration and will then be given an allotted amount of time to present their findings and recommendations. The winning team will be chosen by a panel of experts and all participants will be recognized at the awards banquet during the conference.
