William C. Friday Graduate Student College-Sport Research Paper Award

CHAPEL HILL, NC – The College Sport Research Institute and the Department of Exercise and Sport Science at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill announce the **William C. Friday Graduate Student College-Sport Research Paper Award** to be given at the **2010 Scholarly Conference on College Sport**. The conference will be held at the **William and Ida Friday Center** in Chapel Hill from **April 21-23, 2010**.

To be eligible for this award, students must be enrolled as a graduate student in a college or university and not be employed in a full-time academic position at the deadline for submission, which is February 12, 2010. Papers should reflect a student's analytical and/or theoretical research related to college sport and be appropriate for presentation at the 2010 conference. The winner will have the opportunity to present their research at the 2010 Scholarly Conference on College Sport while having their conference registration fee waived.
