### **Guidelines for Submitting via Email Requests to Count UNC Courses Toward the INTS Major**

Please follow these guidelines carefully, so that we may dispose of your requests as quickly and efficiently as possible.

1. Provide the name and number of the course.
2. Provide a detailed description of the course, if not a syllabus. Do not assume Dr. Weiler will know what the course is just by the department name and number.
3. Keep in mind the guidelines, as outlined in various places on the website, for acceptable courses in the majors. These include:
  - That all courses have a contemporary focus requirement. That is, that they predominantly cover the period of the mid/late 19th century to the present.
  - That theme courses be transnational in scope. That is, that they substantially focus on more than one country.
  - That area courses focus predominantly on the relevant geographical area.
4. Please indicate clearly what you are trying to get the course approved for, specifying what theme or what area you want it to count for.
5. If you are asking Dr. Weiler to communicate with your academic advisor about a course that you are trying to get approved to count toward your major, you need to tell him who your advisor is and include her or his email address.
