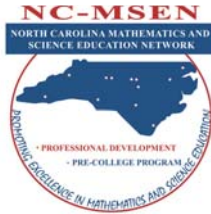


# North Carolina Mathematics and Science Education Network (NC-MSEN)



## Congratulations to Dr. David C. Royster

Dr. David Royster, Director of the NC-MSEN Center at UNC Charlotte, received the prestigious W. W. Rankin Award at the NCCTM conference last week.

The North Carolina Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCCTM) is the professional organization in North Carolina of all persons responsible for the teaching of mathematics.

Its membership includes teachers from all levels, kindergarten through graduate school, and other professionals who work with curriculum and materials for the teaching of mathematics.



The Rankin Award is designed to recognize and honor individuals for their outstanding contributions to NCCTM and to mathematics education in North Carolina. It is named in memory of W. W. Rankin, Professor of Mathematics at Duke University. Presented in the fall at the State Mathematics Conference, this is the highest honor NCCTM can bestow upon an individual.
