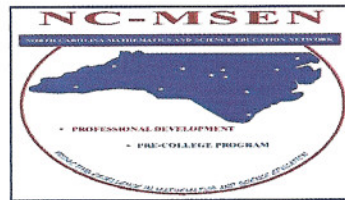

Students from all seven MSEN Pre-college sites competed in Calculus, Algebra, Biology, Engineering and Design, Bottle Rocket, and Lego Robotics to name a few.

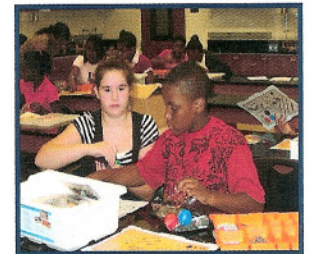
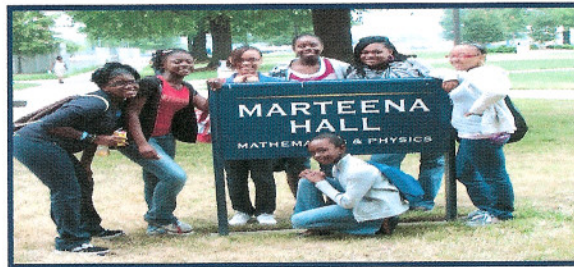
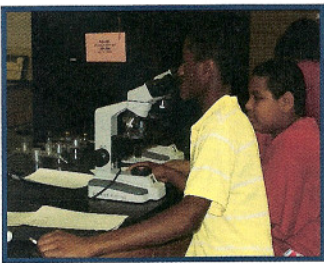
