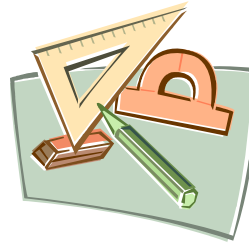

## Closing Sessions Spring 2011

The Spring semester closing session was held on Saturday May 7, 2011 in the School of Business & Economics' Shaw Auditorium. Breakfast was served at 8:30am. The program started at 9:30 with a welcome from Grayling Williams, Interim Director of the Math/Science Education Center. The Speaker for the occasion was Mr. Derrick Raphael.

Derrick is an alumnus of the FSU Pre-College Program. He graduated from Princeton University in 2006. He received a ReachOut '56 Fellowship to create a comprehensive college preparation program at the Spring Lake Middle School and Pine Forest High School through a partnership with the Cumberland County School System. He also helped to create the curriculum for a college preparation start-up company. He is currently at Duke University School of Law.
