- enrollment at HBCUs was 13.83 % White
- enrollment at historically White institutions was 10.36% Black
- this was the highest level ever achieved in the University and at historically White institutions - it was the 2nd year in a row that Black students exceeded 10% of the total enrollment in historically White institutions
- 43.8% of UNC's Black students were enrolled in historically White institutions
- throughout UNC, Black student enrollment was 20.6% of total student enrollments
- at HBCUs, Black student enrollment was 82.3% of total enrollments
