## **"Two Kinds of Recognition Respect for Persons"**

In the Second-Person Standpoint, I argue that persons have an authority or standing to make claims of one another, which makes us mutually accountable, and which can only adequately be respected second-personally also, that is, in how we relate to one another. But there is also another form of respect for persons that is evidenced especially in honor cultures and that can be in tension with this. I investigate the difference between these and their moral significance.
