Most Requested/ Suggested Equipment	Cost Code	Description
Hosmer Baseball Glove Attachment	\$	Terminal glove device allowing a firm grip between thumb and forefinger (Vendor # 1)
Aud-A-Ball Beeper Ball	\$	Ball with a beeper inside, (Vendor # 3)
Fleece Covered Softball	\$	Fleece covered for indoor or outdoor use (Vendor # 2)
No Miss Mit	\$	For children with neurological disabilities. Velcro and velvet covered ball. (Vendor # 4)
Fielders Face Guard	\$	Face guard for unstable or hand to mouth players. (Vendor # 5)
Hi Fly Fielder/ Power Swing Ring	\$\$	Glove that eliminates need for wrist or forearm rotation; ring for wooden bats that also eliminates need for wrist rotation. Baseball or softball, (Vendor # 6)

Game Modifications:

Baseball: Give them an option of a batting apparatus and unlimited swings.
 Allow for pinch runners.
 Freeze play when a player who can't throw catches a ball and let a buddy throw.

General: Allow more time-outs and free substitution.
 Lengthen time limits or modify distances.
 Play with buddies (in volleyball, two players hold hands and use one each).
