<b>Game Modifications:</b>
<p><b>Basketball:</b> Lengthen the three-second lane rule. Let buddies push wheelchairs and let players carry the ball in a lap tray. Use a partially inflated playground ball for easier grip.</p> <p><b>General:</b> Allow more time-outs and free substitution. Lengthen time limits or modifying distances. Play with buddies (in volleyball, two players hold hands and use one each). Adjust the height of the goal for younger/weaker players; gradually raise.</p>
