Requested/ Suggested General Equipment	Cost Code	Description
Perkins Narrow Paper Adapter	\$	Attaches to Perkins Braille Writer. Eliminates problem of lines running together on narrow paper. (Brochures, leaflets) (Vendor # 1)
Transcribex	\$	A print to Braille translation program for Apple computers. (Vendor # 2)
Book Holder	\$	Foam padding holds books upright, allows for page turning with one hand. (Vendor # 4)
<b>Bex 3.1*</b>	\$\$	Gives voice, large print, and Braille output for Apple computers. (Vendor # 2)
<b>Perkins Brailier*</b>	\$\$\$	Writes in English, French, German, and Spanish. Large cell option for those with tactile problems as well. Portable, adjustable margins, electric or manual. (Vendor # 1)
Automatic Page Turner	\$\$\$	Assists readers with paralysis; turns pages with command of light finger touch. (Vendor # 4)
Romeo Braille Printer	\$\$\$\$	IBM-PC compatible, (Vendor # 3)
