1. Proposed rewording of final exam requirement in Criteria document:

*First Year seminars, composition courses, and other courses designed specifically to nurture a creative process [?] are exempt from the requirement of an in-class final exam; Experiential Education courses may have some form of final project or final evaluation of student work in lieu of a final examination. [This is a follow up from earlier meetings].*  
Example: DRAM 231

2. Beyond the North Atlantic vs. Global Issues:

Courses focused on global processes, but not rooted in a particular non-NA regions: should they satisfy both Global and BN requirements? The argument for: little of the class content focuses on North Atlantic region (ergo, the course is BN by default). The argument against: the class does not introduce students to the culture/history/geography of a particular region or regions beyond the North Atlantic, or at least not in a sustained, systematic fashion.

Examples: ANTH 344, INTS 281, INTS 410
