  - Linked Courses  
Create an additional suffix?
  - Planetarium Labs  
Some Physics courses offer both regular labs and planetarium labs and wish to differentiate between the two. Create an additional suffix?
  - Level 4 Foreign Language Courses  
If a student places into Level 4 course, that course must count as a Foundations course, but when it is offered to other students, it is offered as a Connections and/or Approaches course. Web does not allow Foundations course to also be Approaches and/or Connections. Create additional suffix for Foundations section of that course?
  - Special Topics, Independent Study, Research courses offered to both undergraduates and graduates  
Assign 490, 590, 690 to Special Topics courses offered to both undergraduates and graduates; 495, 595, 695 to Research courses offered to both undergraduates and graduates; 496, 596, 696 to Independent Studies offered to both undergraduates and graduates?
  - Senior Honors Thesis Courses  
Update: 691, 692, 693, 694 (Senior Honors Thesis courses) are now 691H, 692H, 693H, 694H for consistency.
