**Grades:** 11-12

*A webquest geared at gaining real life experience using the euro in Spain.*

**Time:** 50+ minutes depending on allowance to browse the web pages and length of discussion following activity.

**Objectives:** To gain real life experience using the euro and making comparisons to the dollar.

**Materials Needed:**

1. World Wide Web
2. Worksheet provided

1. **First Step:** Find the current currency conversion between the euro and the USD.
2. **Second Step:** Complete webquest provided.

**Formal assessment:** Completed worksheet with correct conversions between the euro and the USD.

**Informal assessment:** Discussion following the activity surrounding the culture and fashion differences addressed in this lesson as well as the current state of the US economy and how the euro has gained strength through the European Union.
