Teeth

- I. Using this lab sheet or your own paper, create charts to help you side teeth. It's a good idea to create one chart for each of the 7 tooth types we've gone over in class (adult I/C/P/M, subadult I/C/M). As you read through White and van Beek, jot down the ways in which the teeth can be differentiated into maxillary or mandibular; first, second, or third; and left or right. An example from the incisors is provided to get you started.

Upper vs. Lower

↑ broad crown relative to height.

Position in Arch

- I¹ crowns are larger than I² crowns.

Left vs. Right

- ▶ In labial view, the distal occlusal surface is more rounded than mesial.
