When you are done, upload it to your webspace (on the UNC server, this is public_html).

To use the tutorial below, you should remove any of the text surrounded by [square brackets] (including the brackets) before you save.

`<html> [Starts the html document.]`

`<head> [Starts the head.]`

`<title>This title will show up above the navigation bar.</title>`

`</head> [Ends the head.]`

`<body> [Starts the body.]`

`
` puts in a line break. Anything after it will show up on the next line.`
`

`<p>` starts a new paragraph. Anything after it show up after one skipped line.`
`

`<h1>`This will be in large "heading" text.`</h1>
`

`<h2>`This will be in slightly smaller "heading" text. `</h2>
`

`<h3>`This will be in yet smaller "heading" text. `</h3>
`

`<i>`This text will be italicized.`</i>
`

``This text will be bold. `
`

`<u>`This text will be underlined. `</u>
`

`<center>`This will be centered. `</center>
`

``This will link to another page.`
`

``This will also link to a file.``

`` That allows you to include a picture

`<hr>` This creates a horizontal line across the page.

`<!--` This text will be "commented" out on the web, but visible in the source code `-->`

`</body>` [Ends the body.]

`</html>` [Ends the html document.]
