- ❖ An FSA ID gives you access to Federal Student Aid’s online systems and serves as your digital signature.
- ❖ Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use.
The student should have an FSA ID of their own, and so should at least one parent.
- ❖ If you had a PIN, having that PIN number available will make this process easier.
- ❖ To create an FSA ID, go to fsaid.ed.gov
- ❖ Complete this form to keep track of your FSA ID information. This should be kept confidential and stored in a secure location.
